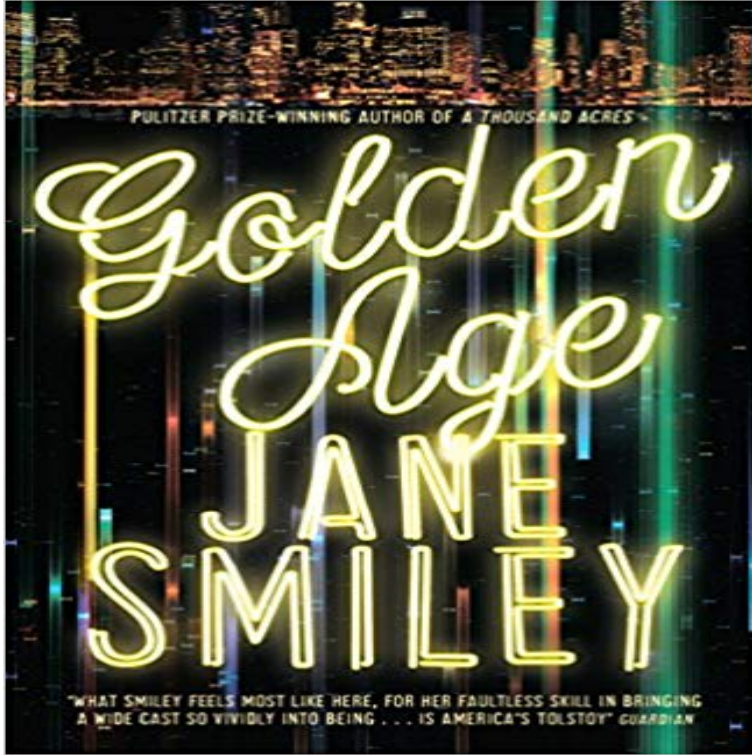


Golden Age (Last Hundred Years Trilogy)
