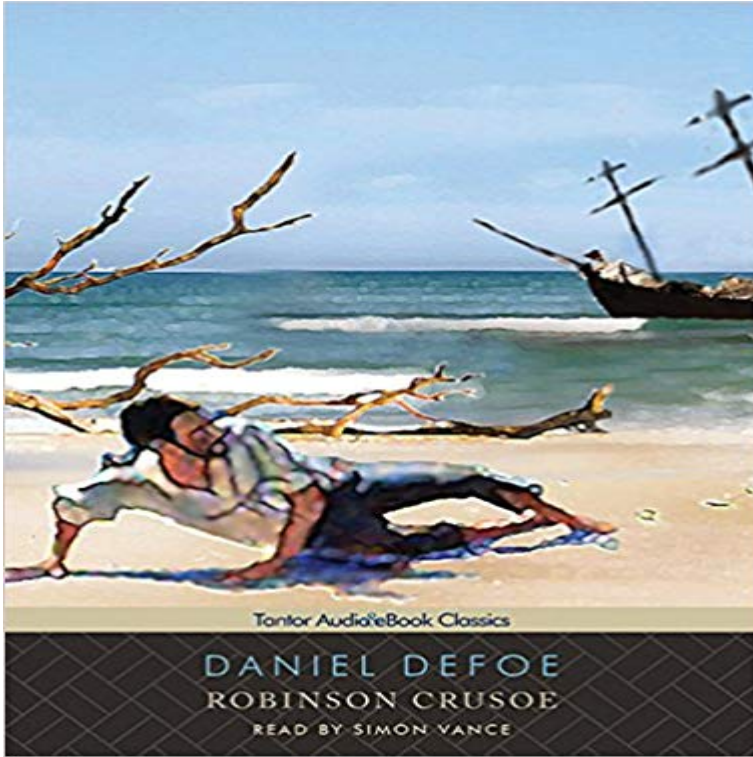


# Robinson Crusoe
