


Northrop Frye on Shakespeare



With his latest book, Frye continues to solidify his reputation as one of the most important literary theorists and critics of the 20th century. By concentrating on a handful of Shakespeares plays, Frye can elaborate on the theory, developed in his groundbreaking study *Anatomy of Criticism*, that all literature reenacts ancient myths and rituals that, though outside consciousness, still exert a powerful influence on our perception. Because Shakespeare manipulates these instinctual perceptions, he can speak to us as a voice at once in the past and the present, not of an age, but for all time.
