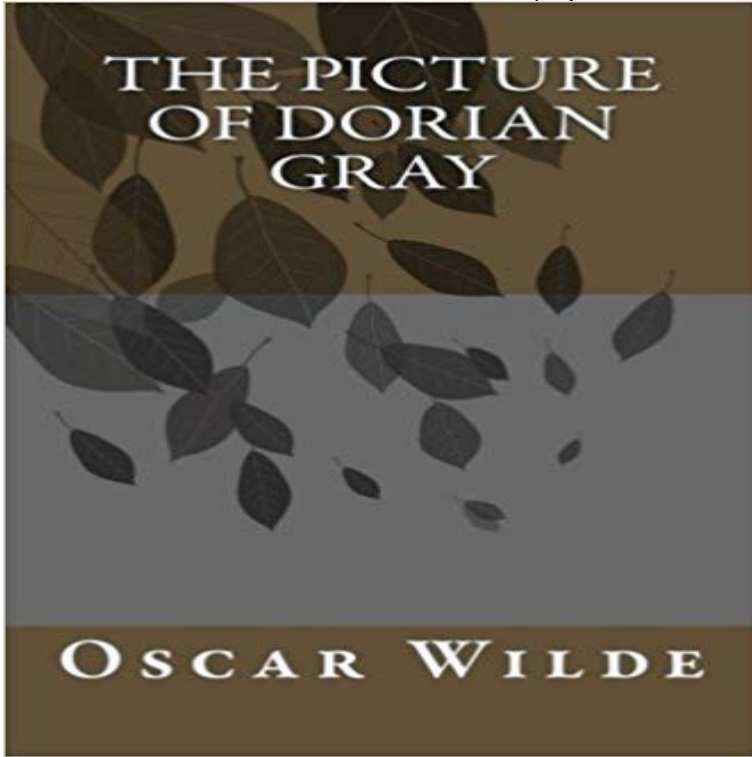


The Picture Of Dorian Gray (Wilde Collections)

The wish is granted, and Dorian pursues a libertine life of varied and amoral experiences; all the while his portrait ages and records every soul-corrupting sin.
