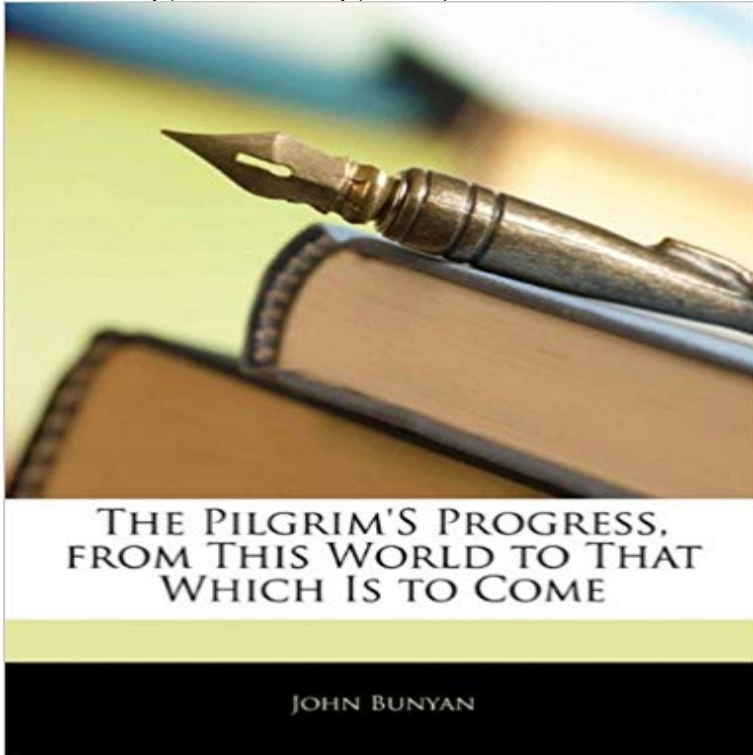


The Pilgrims Progress, from This World to That Which Is to Come
