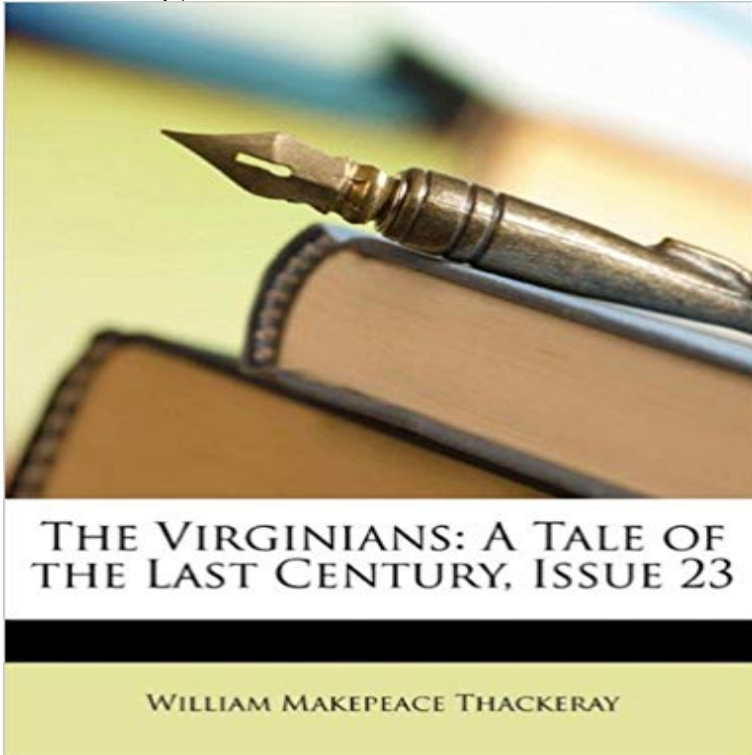


The Virginians: A Tale of the Last Century, Issue 23
