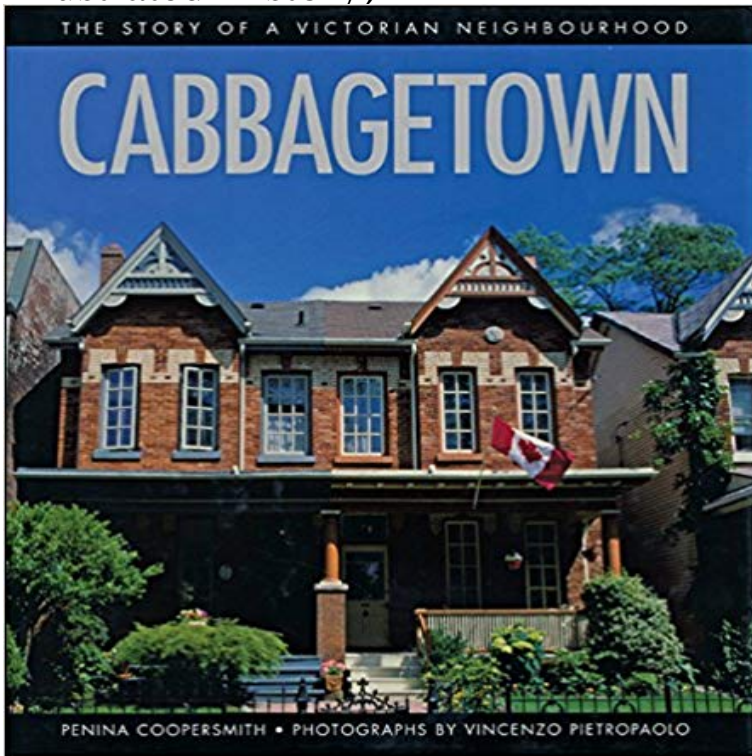


Cabbagetown: The Story of a Victorian Neighbourhood (Lorimer Illustrated History)
